I LOVE YOU, I THANK YOU, AND MOST OF ALL I THANK GOD FOR USING YOU AND YOUR FAMILY TO

This is only one testimony of what God has done through this ministry.

One of our friends has severe eye problems that has drastically interfered with his sight. Under normal circumstances anyone who has to deal with blindness is hindered however, one who lives on the streets in such a condition is in extreme danger. Our friend is scheduled for surgery next month but he has to get his identification prior to the surgery. Last week a friend gave me money for the ministry and I told her I knew exactly what that money would go towards. Last Sunday I was able to give our blind, homeless friend the money to get his I.D. and he was very thankful.

We still long for the day when we will have a facility which will allow us to be more helpful to our park friends on a regular basis. Keep praying that God will open the doors and bring in the support needed to accomplish this but only in His timing.

Also keep our park friends in your prayers as they continue to be harassed by the police being falsely accused of loitering when they were actually just walking or acting as a paying customer in a store or restaurant.

If there is anything we can do to help them get off the streets and better their lives for the glory of God, we are willing vessels to be used for such a task.

Thank you for sending us out as missionaries to reach out to the unfortunate right here in

our own country, our own state, offering them a ray of hope for the glory of God.
