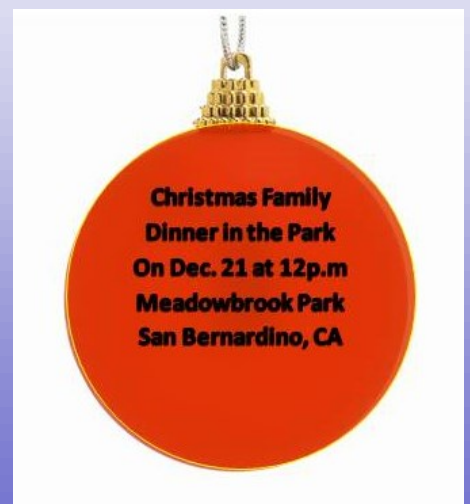


We are also excited about our upcoming plans in December. On Dec. 21st we are planning a Family Christmas Dinner in the park for our friends.

This will provide them with the ability to generate income, gain experience in a new trade and help them to turn over that new leaf. At The King's Fishers Ministries we will be providing them with the ability to learn how to manage their new trade which will lead to them getting off the streets.

The Kings Fishers Ministries is a non-profit organization therefore we would like to offer our service of work requesting a donation. Please keep in mind the goal of this ministry when donating. We are asking for your consideration to donate to help with the expenses with this new phase. Any work that you
