



We may not always know what God is doing in our lives and/or ministry but nevertheless we must trust Him. In prayer for direction in this new season of our lives God spoke the word...shifting.



things are not running as smoothly as they had once before. What is wrong? What has happened? You try everything in your human power to make things like they used to be but this will never happen.


God has opened a door for The King's Fishers Ministries to partner with another body of believers who support this ministry by offering their facility to allow us to feed the homeless spiritually and physically. Donations had not been coming in for our regular weekly park outreach and we were trying to make it happen anyway but we kept getting discouraged. God had spoken for us to continue with the outreach every 3rd Sunday of each month but to focus on building up the support system of the ministry by spreading the word of the vision in which God has given us which could be read in detail on our website.

The course has changed in this ministry during this new season. However, this is not a negative statement but it is simply that things are different. When God shifts the ministry and we do not shift with it, we will get off course. If we get off course, God will not be present with us for He has moved on, but we have not followed Him yet because we were comfortable in our own complacency. Therefore His presence (protection, favor... glory ) will not be there either. We will be

operating in vanity building on our own foundation, which will be burned at the end of time, rather than building on the foundation of Christ that will remain until the end.



“Then Moses said to Him, ‘If your presence is not going [with us], don't make us leave this place.’” (Ex.33:15) Moses recognized that it was vital to be in a place where God was present. We need to recognize shifts in



our lives/ministry, accept them, trust and follow God.

On September 21, 2014 we had our first outreach at True Vine Ministries in which Richard first shared a sermon and following that we fed roughly 125 people a spaghetti lunch. Although we thought we had plenty of spaghetti, along with side dishes, it was not



enough for everyone to have their fill. We will be focusing on gathering the necessary supplies for each month so everybody could enjoy a healthy-sized plate of delicious spaghetti which was made by one of our faithful

supporters. Richard will share a message of hope and God will bring the increase.

God has a great plan beyond anything we can fathom for you in your life and for this ministry. “But as Scripture says: 'No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined the things that God has prepared for those who love him.'” (1 Cor. 2:9).
